GENERAL:

Participation in the Ringhoffer Cup 2015 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 c) and d) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420 or any update of it.

Place of the competition: **Ice Rink HC KOBRA, Mikuleckého 1584, Prague 4**

The rink is indoor, but not heated.

Date of the competition: 17. 2. 2015 – 20. 2. 2015

ENTRIES:

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

All ISU members and clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part at the competition. Each member and club may enter 2 competitors in each category (2 males and 2 females).

The organizing union and club reserve the right to enter more competitors. In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

The maximum entries accepted will be 30 in each category.

Competitors to Advance Novice and Junior categories is open for club. Entries for younger categories may be entered by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU.

Deadline for entries: All entries (competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other participants) are expected to be mailed to the organizers address not later than **February 2nd 2015.** If it is possible, e-mail entries are preferred. Only entries including the following information will be accepted:

- Name of the competitor
- Date of birth
- Category
- Member Federation
- Name of the Club

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" for Chicks, Cubs, Springs, Debs, Advance Novices and Junior categories must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet will be filled precisely by each Skater in English using terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Entry fee is 40 EUR per skater. The entry fee must be paid for each competitor at the Registration before the competition.

Participating teams must announce changes in their teams immediately after their arrival.

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE B I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Basic Novice B skater is who was born: 1.7.1999 - 30.6.2000

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE B II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Basic Novice B skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2000 – 30. 6. 2001

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE B BOYS

Age requirements: Basic Novice B skater is a person born: 1. 7. 1999 - 30. 6. 2001

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE A I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Basic Novice A skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2001 – 30. 6. 2002

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1760 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE A II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Basic Novice A skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2002 – 30. 6. 2003

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE A III. GIRLS

Age requirements: Basic Novice A skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2003 – 30. 6. 2004

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE A BOYS

Age requirements: Basic Novice A skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2001 – 30. 6. 2004

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2012, ISU Communication 1886 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2004 – 30. 6. 2005

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2005 – 30. 6. 2006

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS BOYS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2004 – 30. 6. 2006

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel-type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps can be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

c) There must be a maximum:

- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5

CHICKS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2006 – 30. 6. 2007

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is a person born: 1. 7. 2007 or later.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS BOYS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is, who was born: 1. 7. 2006 or later

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

<p>a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.</p>
<p>b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.</p>
<p>c) There must be a maximum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.– for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
<p>Level explanation: For Chicks in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.</p>
<p>The Program Components are only judged in</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Skating Skills- Performance/Execution <p>The factor of the Program Components is 2.5</p>

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS: All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.

EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY: Ringhoffer Cup is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2014/15 for Junior, Advance Novice and younger categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. The age requirements and the special regulation for the European Criterium Trophy are published on the website of the EC: www.europeancriterium.eu.

JUDGES: Each ISU Member participating on the competition may enter one or more International or ISU Judge for different disciplines. Each panel of Judges in Junior and Novice categories will consist of 5 judges and 3 judges in younger categories. Accommodation with full board in **Hotel Štiřín****** will be covered by the organizer from dinner on February 16th until lunch on February 20th, 2015 or for the days when

the Judge is on duty. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Member via E-mail.

EXPENSES: Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board only for the confirmed Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists in **Hotel Štířín******. Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other team officials will not be covered by the organizer.

AWARDS: The Organizer provides diplomas for all competitors after each event. The three best Skaters in each category will be awarded a medal.

MUSIC: Music will be played from a CD player. Each competitor must deliver a CD with his/her program music track(s) to the Registration Office immediately after arrival. The CD must be labelled by the name of the competitor, the club and the category which he/she competes in.

ORGANISING COMMITTEE: The Office of the Organizing Committee will be located at the ice arena.

ACCOMODATION: All participants except Judges, Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists must cover their accommodation expenses by themselves.
